He couldn't see any way, so he fell into a deep depression and decided to end his life at the Golden Gate Bridge. That's where he met retired California Highway Patrol Officer Kevin Briggs, who intervened and talked him down. The message of these champions of suicide prevention and survival will be inspirational and a source of hope and healing. The day will conclude with a presentation about surviving the grief of suicide loss by Cheryl Waters, IWC, Suicide Prevention Specialist and Crisis Interventionist and facilitated loss support groups for attendees.
