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#### **ABOUT THE CONFERENCE...**

**On Thursday, January 26, 2023,** as part of the Kevin's Song Conference on Suicide, Kevin's Song will host its 4th Annual **The School Summit** that will bring together public, independent, parochial and charter schools to share best practices in suicide awareness and prevention. Educators and mental health professionals who work with young people will learn about creative, innovative programs that are bringing mental health and suicide awareness to students, teachers and parents throughout Michigan.

Thursday will also mark the first **Professional Trainee and Student Symposium on Suicide –** an intense half-day course on suicide, prevention and treatment from educators, researchers, policymakers and clinicians providing professional trainees and students with basic but crucial information about suicide and its impact on individuals and communities. This half day program is important for trainees entering into professional health fields as well as professionals who are either working with trainees or those who are continuing their

On Friday, January 27, 2023 the Conference will include an array of powerful presentations that will challenge the conventions of suicide prevention and treatment and challenge attendees to rethink how suicide and risk of self-harm can be better assessed, prevented and treated. Topics will include: a dialogue on current prevention efforts and ideas for the future, prevention in the workplace, the impact of 988, innovations in crisis management and treatment, and community efforts to reduce and eliminate stigma.

On Saturday, January 28, 2023, the focus of the Conference is on survivors of suicide loss and helping them to cope with their grief following the suicide of a loved one. The program is also for those with a lived experience of a suicide attempt and to help the people that love and support them.

Featured this year will be a compelling presentation from Kevin Berthia and Kevin Briggs, two nationally known champions of suicide prevention and survival, whose message will be inspirational and a source of hope and healing. The day will conclude with a presentation about surviving the grief of suicide loss and facilitated loss support groups for attendees.





#### **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FILE TYPES**

We accept advertising material in PDF, JPG or TIFF file formats. The PDF file should be press-optimized, Hi-Quality Print and CMYK. Convert all spot colors to CMYK. Outline all fonts. JPG or TIFF images must be saved as CMYK, and submitted at 300 dpi and placed in the ad at 100%, otherwise the image will print at a low quality.

Pictures, Photos and Logos that are incorporated into a website are generally saved at a much lower resolution than is required for printing and are not usable.
